CALIFORNIA SUPREME COURT UPHOLDS ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF GOLDEN STATE WARRIORS MISSION BAY EVENT CENTER *Construction Underway after Official Groundbreaking*

SAN FRANCISCO, CA— “We are thrilled with the California Supreme Court’s denial of the petition for review of the First Appellate District’s decision upholding the Subsequent Environmental Impact Report for the Golden State Warriors Event Center and Mixed-Use Development Project. As a result, the First Appellate District’s decision recognizing the validity of the approval process is now final,” said Tiffany Bohee, Executive Director of the Office of Community Investment and Infrastructure.

Bohee continued, “With the court decision and the official groundbreaking for the Center, construction is moving forward on this vibrant mixed-use project featuring an 18,000-seat arena, restaurants, cafes, offices, a 5.5-acre bayfront park, and public plazas. The development project represents a truly collaborative effort with the Golden State Warriors, our City partners, the University of California San Francisco, neighborhood stakeholders and the broader community.”
