

RESOLUTION NO. 3-99

(Adopted January 12, 1999)

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH MISSION HIRING HALL'S SOUTH OF MARKET EMPLOYMENT CENTER FOR EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$18,500; YERBA BUENA CENTER


BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Agency entered into a Personal Services Contract ("Contract") with Mission Hiring Hall's South of Market Employment Center ("SMEC") to provide employment referral services for the period July 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999, in an amount not to exceed \$227,000.
2. With the opening of both the Starwood (W) Hotel and the Sony Metreon by May 1999, it is necessary to provide additional employment services to low/moderate income Redevelopment Project Area and other San Francisco residents. The Agency wishes to increase the amount of funds under the Contract by \$18,500, to a new aggregate amount not to exceed \$245,500.
3. Funds are available in the Yerba Buena Redevelopment Project Area.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED, that the Executive Director is authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Personal Services Contract with Mission Hiring Hall's South of Market Employment Center in an amount not to exceed \$18,500 and in substantially the form lodged in the office of the Agency General Counsel.
