

RESOLUTION NO. 61-99

AUTHORIZING ATTENDANCE BY THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES MANAGER, AT THE URBAN LAND INSTITUTE'S 1999 REAL ESTATE SCHOOL OF FINANCE IN SAN FRANCISCO FROM JUNE 7-14, 1999 AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,460

BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Urban Land Institute (ULI) is a preeminent national land use and real estate development educational institute which provides relevant and current information about land use and real estate development to its members.
2. ULI will conduct its 1999 real estate finance school in San Francisco including courses structured to provide in-depth knowledge concerning subjects relevant to transactions in which the Agency is involved.
3. It is important for the Development Services Manager to have current knowledge regarding the latest trends in this critical aspect of real estate development.
4. It is therefore appropriate for Darby Kremers, the Agency's Development Services Manger, to attend the ULI Real Estate Finance School in San Francisco from June 7-14, 1999.
