AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE
PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH SIMON MARTIN-VEGUE WINKLESTEIN
MORIS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000
FOR URBAN DESIGN AND PLANNING SERVICES;
HUNTERS POINT SHIPYARD REDEVELOPMENT AREA


BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco ("Agency") is responsible for the management of the land use planning effort for Hunters Point Shipyard ("Shipyard").
2. On October 26, 1993, the Agency Commission authorized a Personal Services Contract ("Contract") with Simon Martin-Vegue Winkelstein Moris ("SMWM") to provide certain planning and communication services for the Shipyard. The Contract was amended on August 16, 1994, November 22, 1994, August 23, 1995, August 14, 1996 and February 17, 1998, thereby increasing the amount under the Contract to \$782,000.
3. SMWM has provided planning services and prepared graphics for presentations and reports in connection with the adoption of the Shipyard Redevelopment Plan. Additionally, the Agency requires planning services to assist staff in the development proposal for the Shipyard. For these services this Contract amendment provides an additional \$25,000.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a Sixth Amendment to the Personal Services Contract with Simon Martin-Vegue Winkelstein Moris to provide additional funding in an amount not to exceed \$25,000, which increases the total Contract amount to \$807,000, and in substantially the form lodged in the office of the Agency General Counsel.
