

RESOLUTION NO. 196-99
(Adopted November 23, 1999)

AUTHORIZING A MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO AND THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$369,784.00 FOR WORK RELATED TO EXISTING REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREAS AND SURVEY AREAS, TO BE COMPLETED IN FISCAL YEAR 1999-2000.

BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Redevelopment Agency requires professional planning services to assist it in implementing adopted redevelopment plans and in proposing and preparing the adoption of new redevelopment plans and plan amendments for Redevelopment Project and Survey Areas, and has received said services from the Planning Department of the City and County of San Francisco in prior fiscal years.
2. The Redevelopment Agency seeks the assistance of the Planning Department for Fiscal Year 1999-2000 and under the terms of the Master Services Agreement, the Agency proposes to reimburse the Planning Department for certain professional planning services rendered between July 1, 1999 and June 30, 2000 in connection with existing Redevelopment Project Areas and Survey Areas.
3. In addition, the Planning Department, in connection with development review for Mission Bay, has performed work in an amount beyond the compensation amount set in the 1998-1999 Master Services Agreement, and the Agency proposes to reimburse the Planning Department \$16,954.00 for this work under the terms of the new Master Services Agreement.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a Master Services Agreement for Fiscal Year 1999-2000 in the amount not to exceed \$369,784.00 with the Planning Department of the City and County of San Francisco, substantially in the form lodged with Agency General Counsel and hereby approved with such changes that hereafter become necessary, which changes do not materially affect the substance of the Master Services Agreement or materially increase the obligations of the Agency.
