OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**

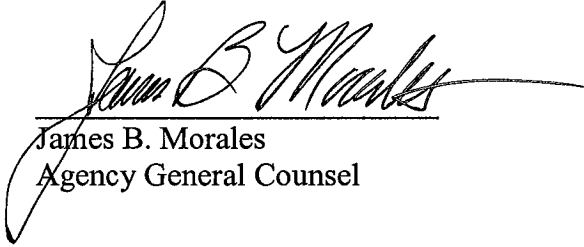
BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

In this capacity, Ms. Gilbert provided specialized records management services which included the organization and processing of records for storage, index compilation, and research and retrieval of Agency-wide records for both staff and the general public.

As the Agency's archives grew in volume and complexity, Ms. Gilbert took on more challenging assignments in keeping with the ongoing records system requirements.
