

RESOLUTION NO. 29-2008

Adopted April 15, 2008

**APPROVING THE PROPOSED BUDGET FOR THE
PERIOD JULY 1, 2008 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2009 AND
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO
SUBMIT THE BUDGET TO THE MAYOR'S OFFICE**

BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. In accordance with the Community Redevelopment Law, the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco is required to establish and adopt a budget ("Budget") for fiscal year 2008-09.
2. The Budget shall be submitted to the Mayor's Office and is subject to the approval of the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco.
3. Approval of the Budget is not a "Project," as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines Sections 15378(b)(4) and 15378(b)(5). The proposed action will not change conditions in any redevelopment project or survey area or at any affordable housing site, will not independently result in a physical change in the environment, and is not subject to environmental review under CEQA.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that its proposed Budget for the period from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 is adopted and the Executive Director is authorized to submit the proposed Budget to the Mayor's Office.
