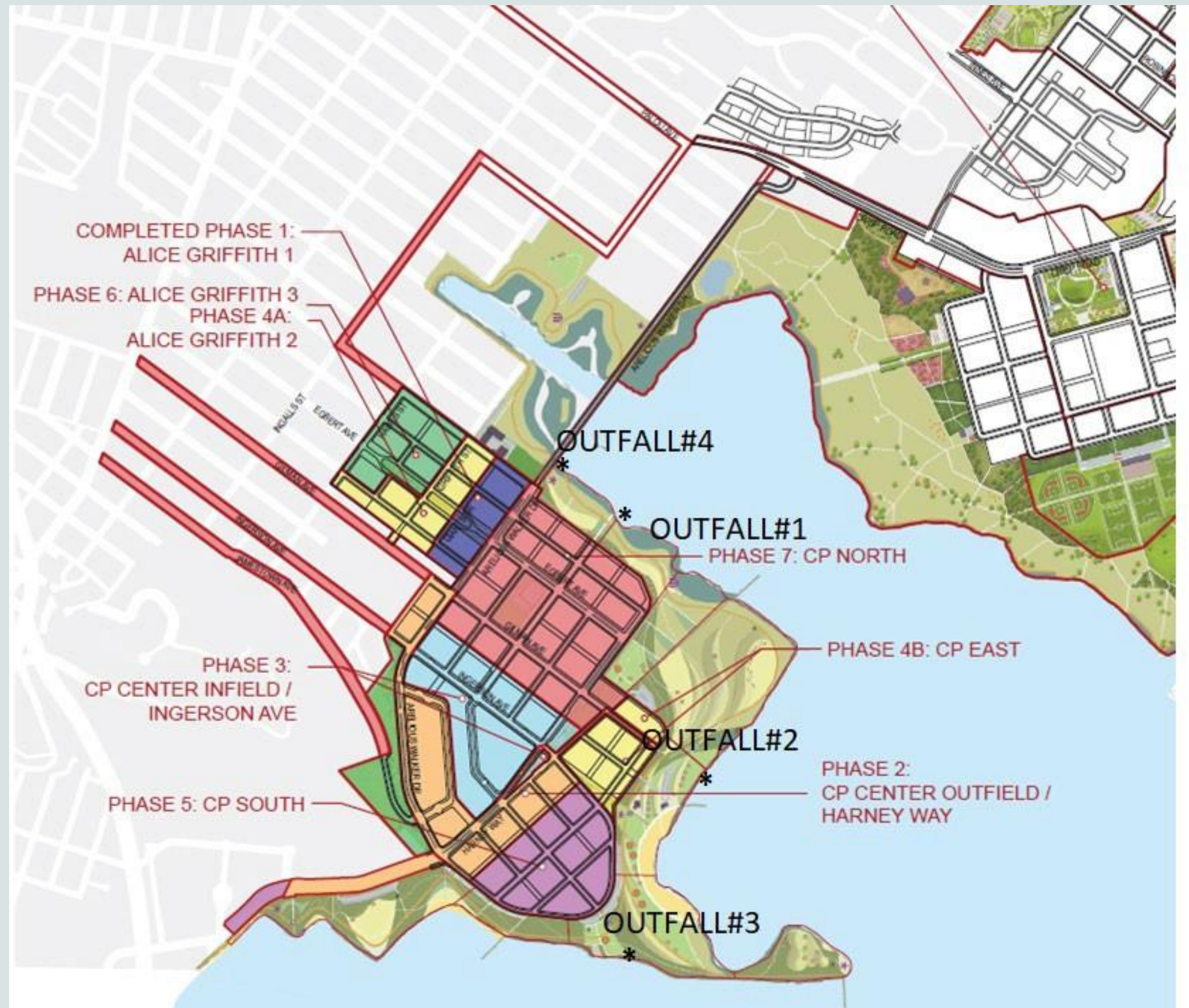

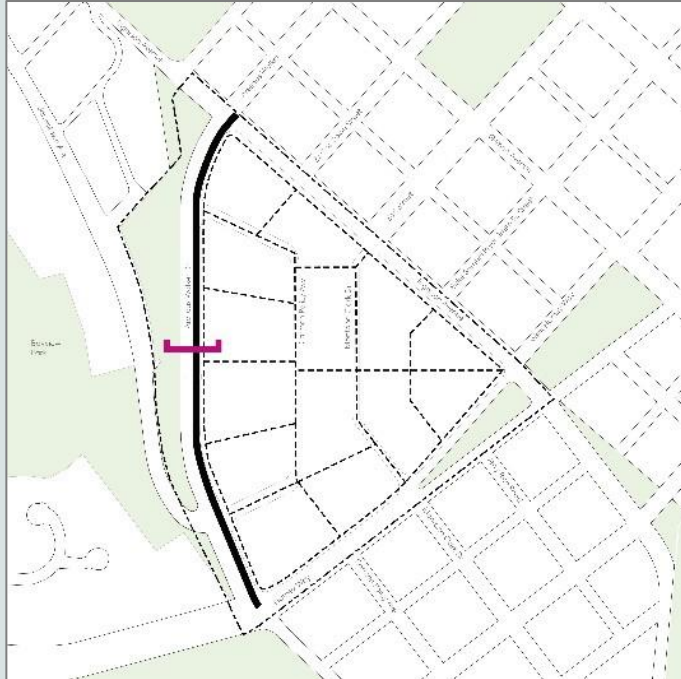

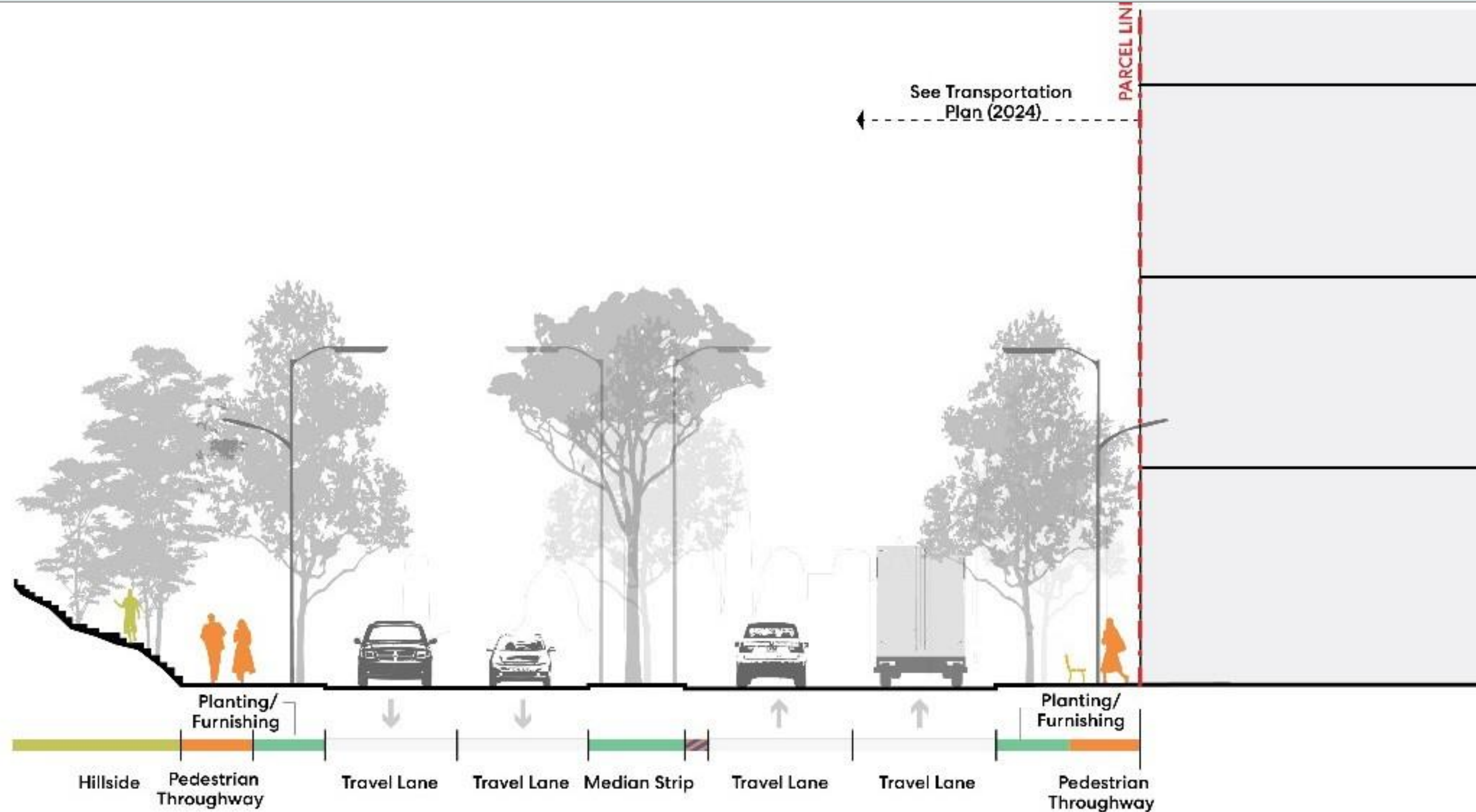


Components of Infrastructure

Street Sections – Arelious Walker Drive directly below the hill at Jamestown Ave.



- Commercial Street
- Modeled after many of San Francisco's most vibrant streets
- Serves as a primary arterial that connects adjacent neighborhoods.

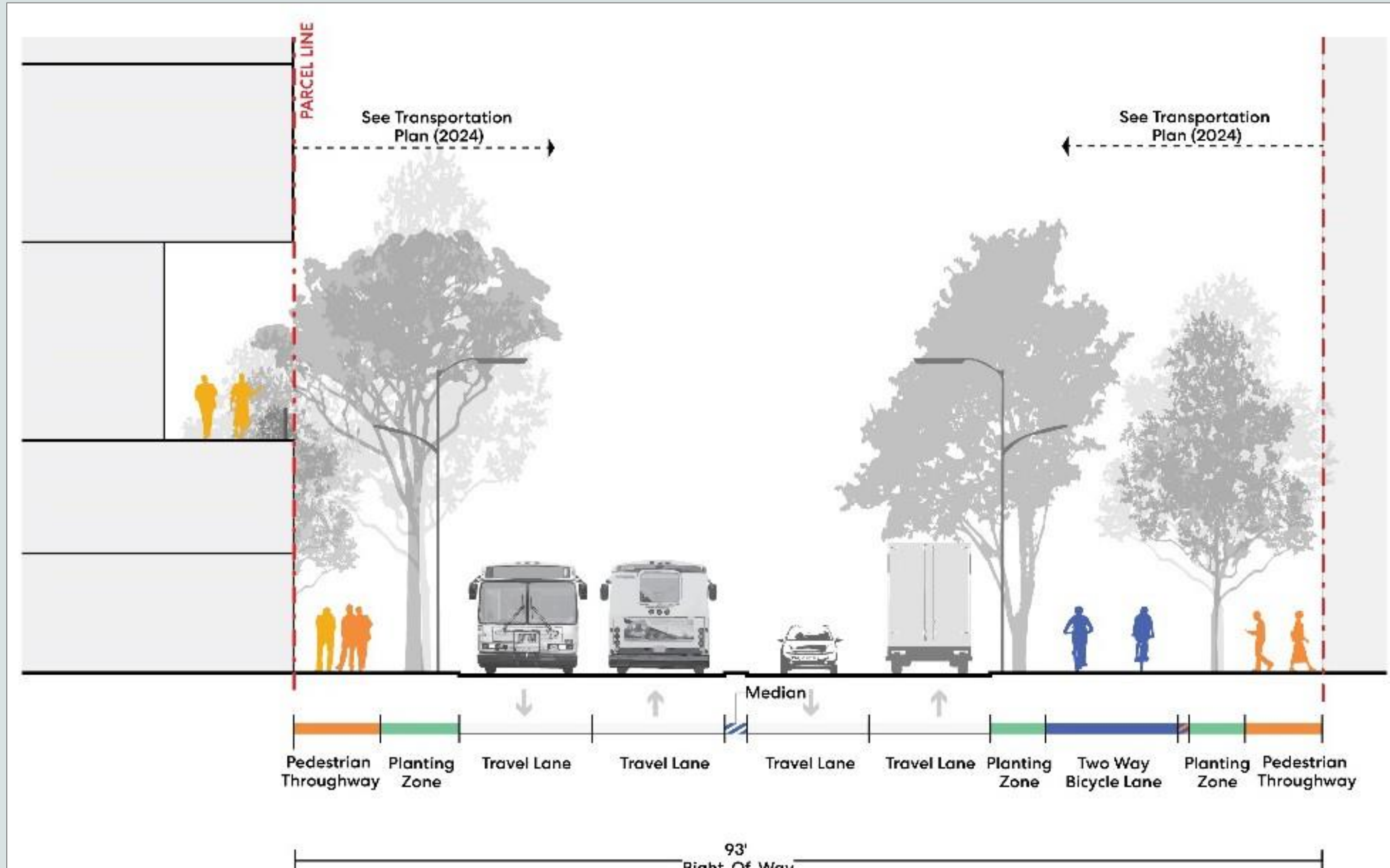


Components of Infrastructure

Street Section – “new” Harney Way, extending existing Harney Way

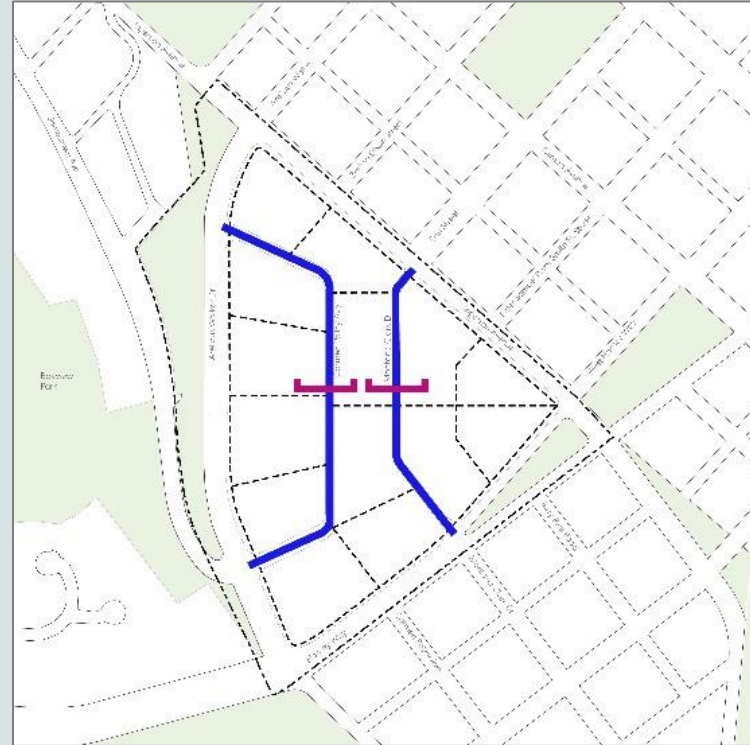


- Commercial Street
- Features BRT/Transit Priority Lane, pedestrian and 2-way bike lanes
- Direct connection between Highway 101 and San Francisco neighborhoods to the north
- Civic backbone, a network of city scale streets

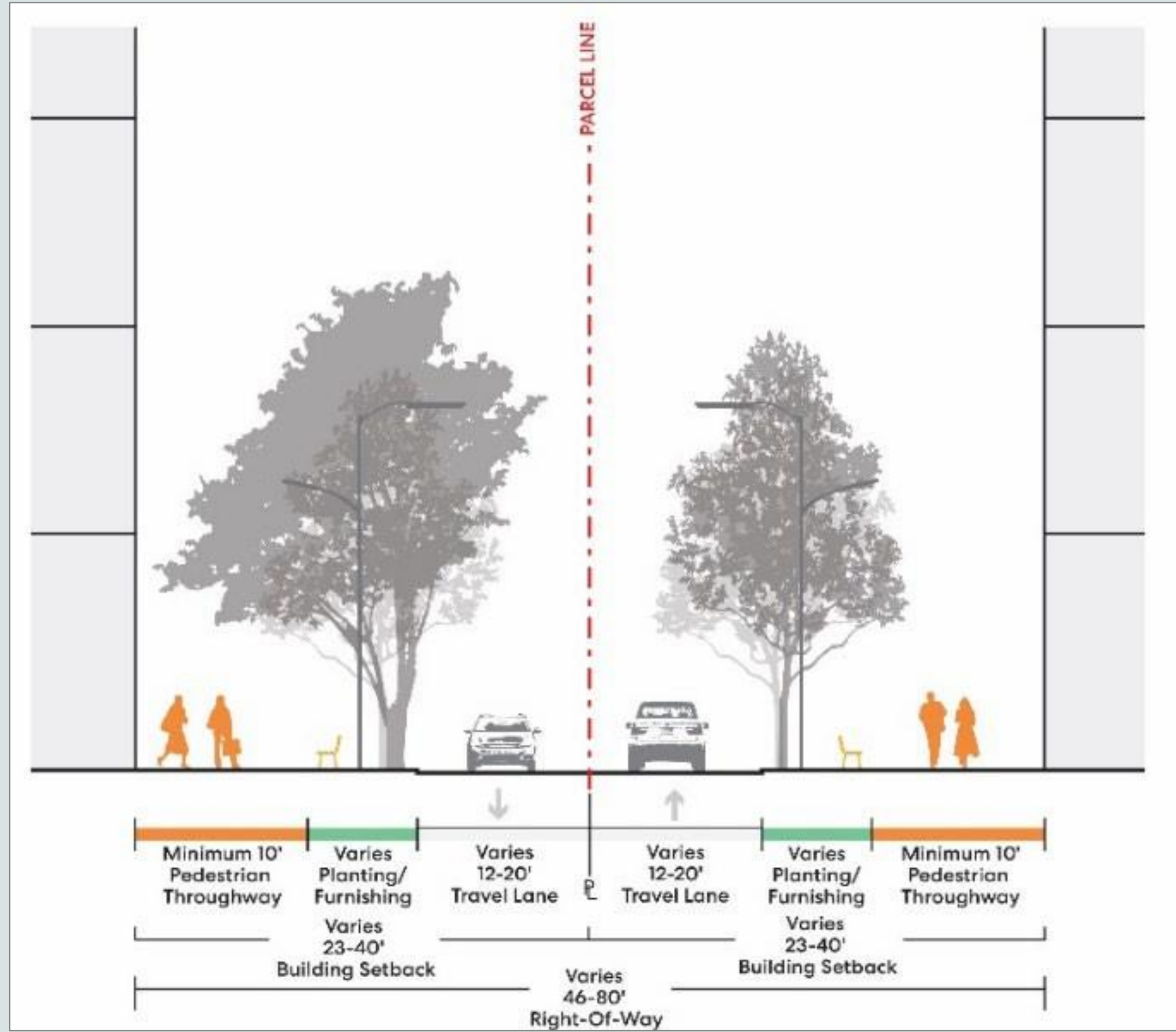


Components of Infrastructure

Street Section – Carmen Policy Ave.



- Interior private street will divide Candlestick Center into blocks
- Connects with the surrounding street grid
- May serve the back-of-house for buildings, including as emergency vehicle access, parking entrances, ADA access, and commercial loading zones, as some of these functions are prohibited on Harney Way and Ingerson Avenue.
