

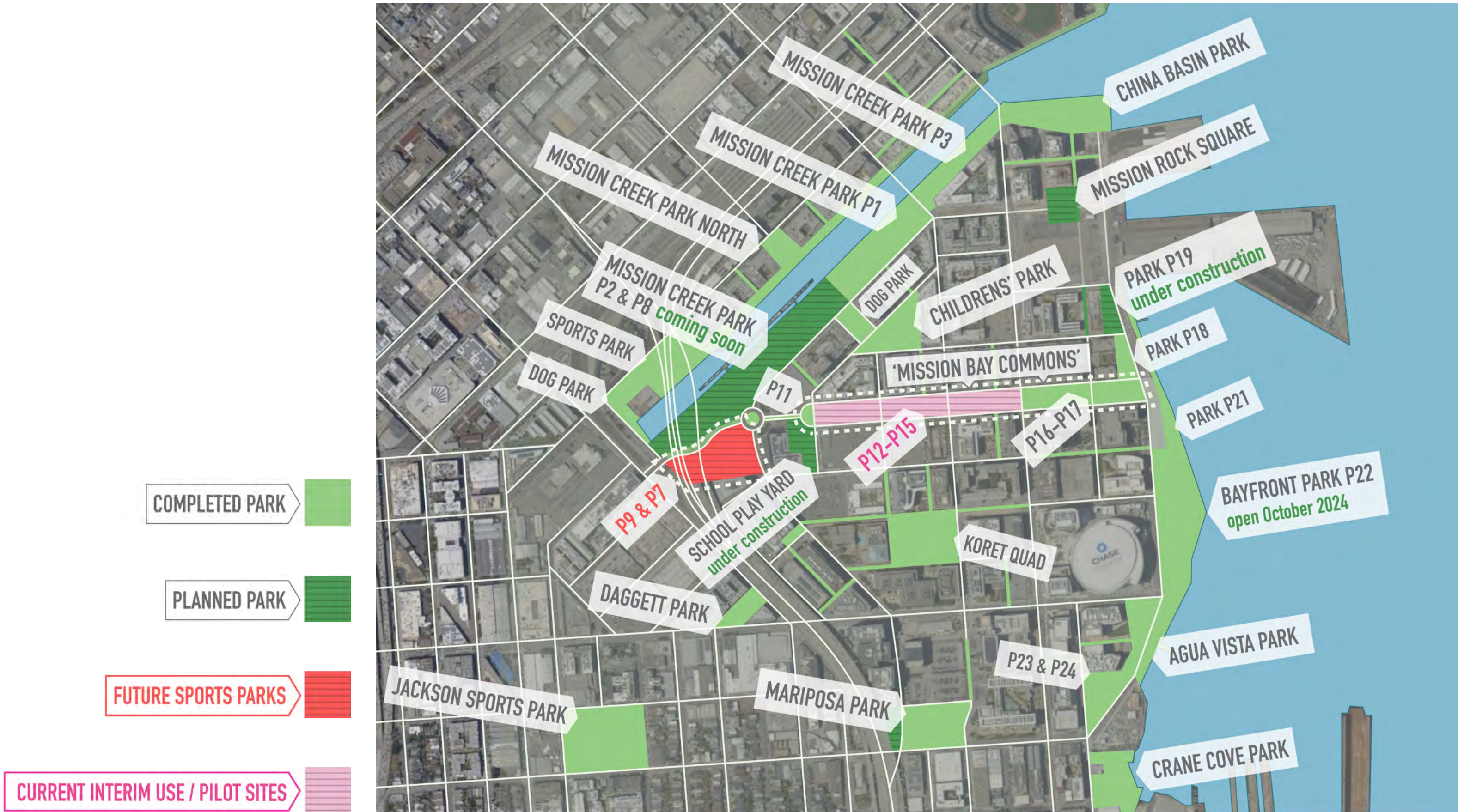

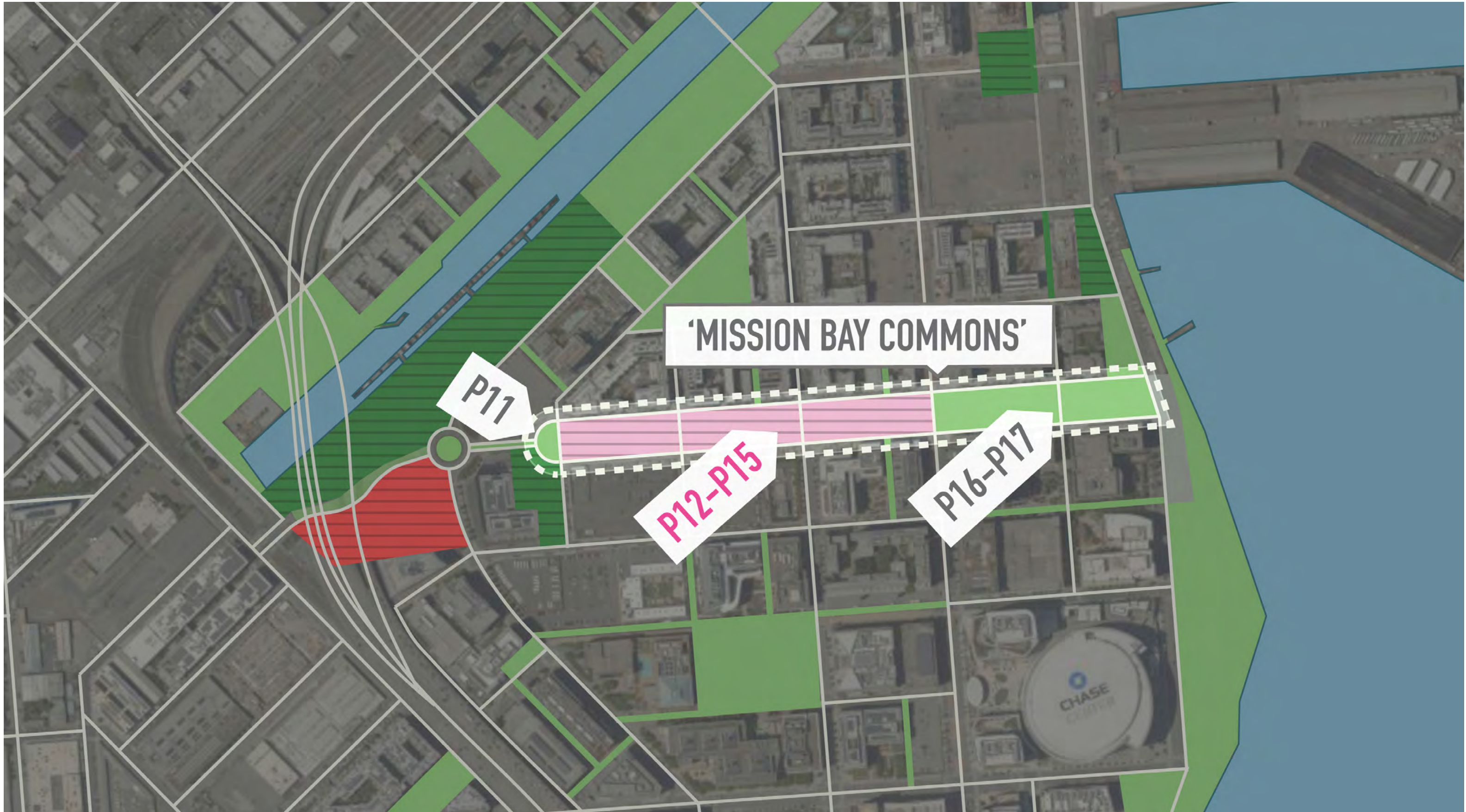

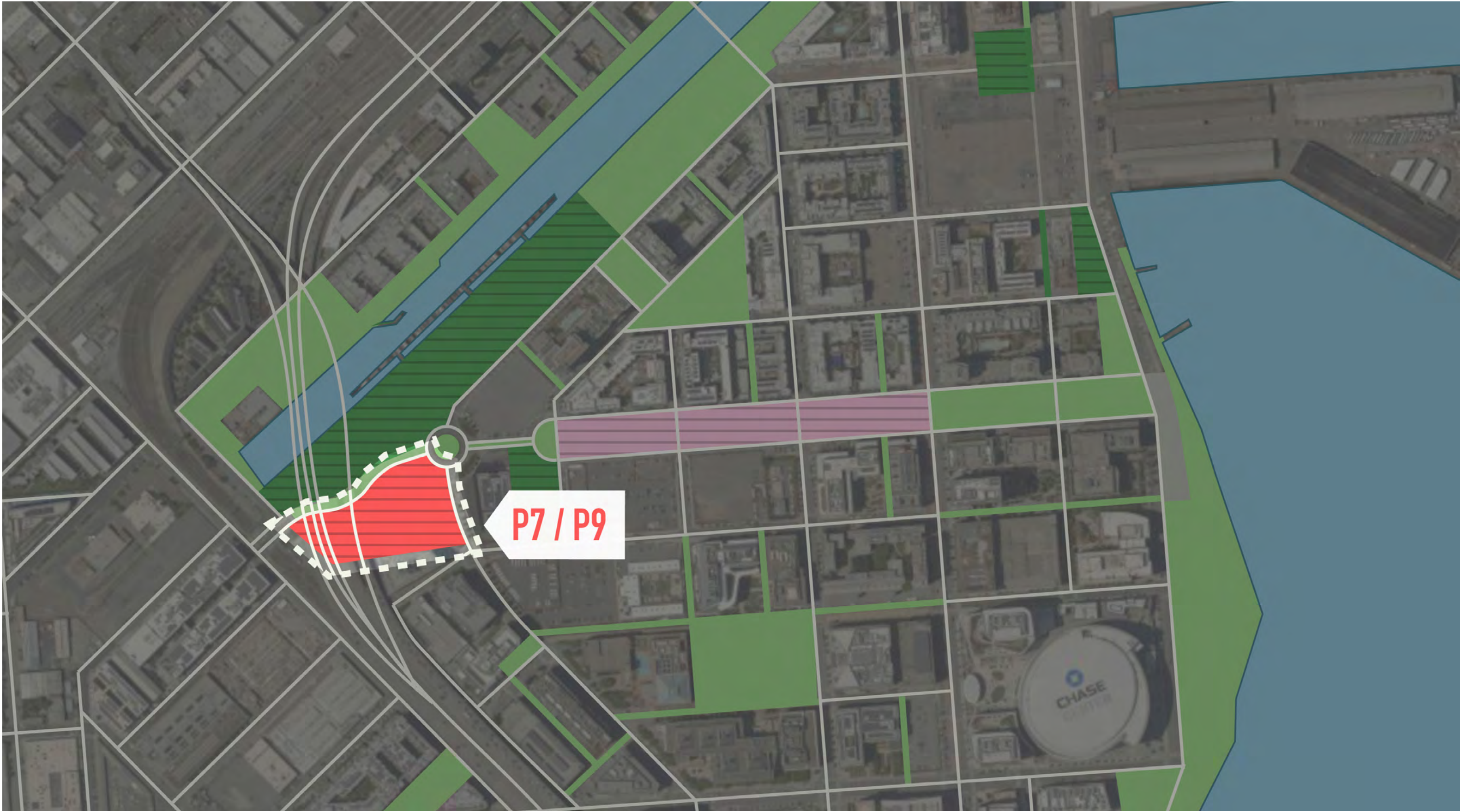

OVERALL GOALS FROM THE 1998 “DESIGN FOR DEVELOPMENT” and 2000 “INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN”

---

- Reinforce **east-west axis** / corridor
- Unified character with a **diversity of activities and uses**
- **Urban open space**: appropriate hardscape (paving) for a variety of uses
- Retail along Mission Bay Blvd, including **kiosks with concessions** in the parks
- Focal point: **social hub** for the neighborhood
- **Meeting ground** between office and residential zones, and UCSF campus
- **Passive and active** uses for children and adults
- **Perimeter sidewalks, trees at edges**, and an interior route through parcels

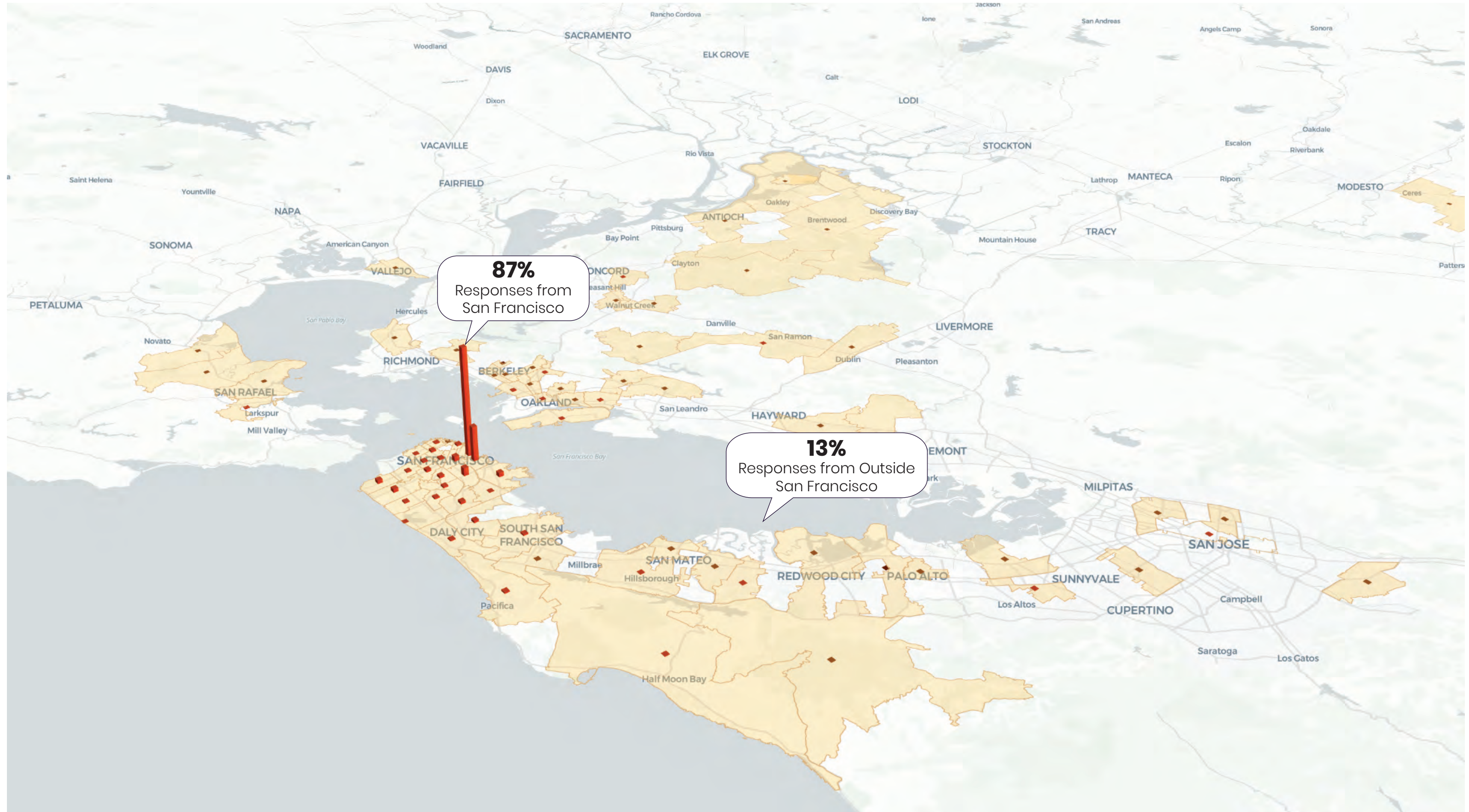

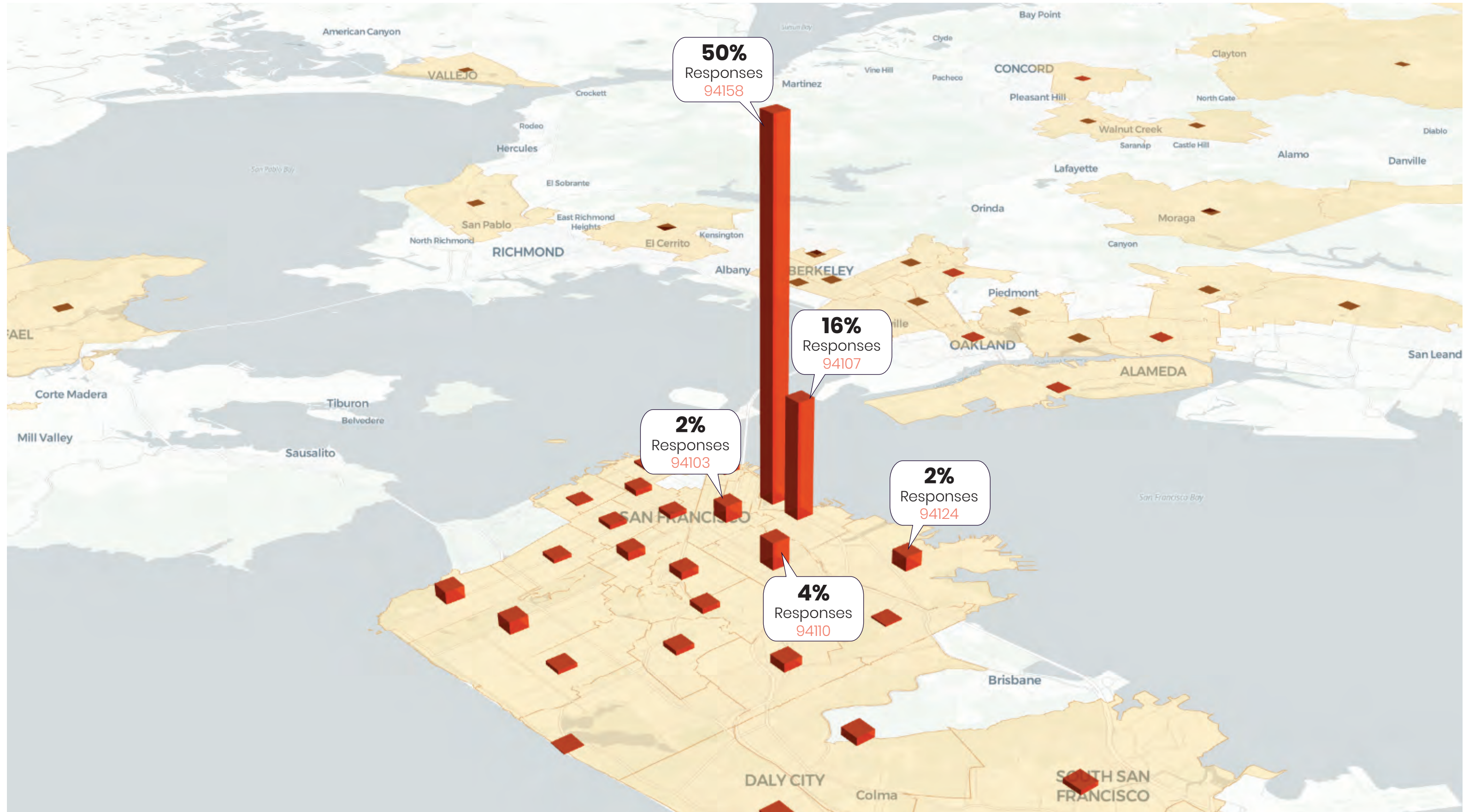

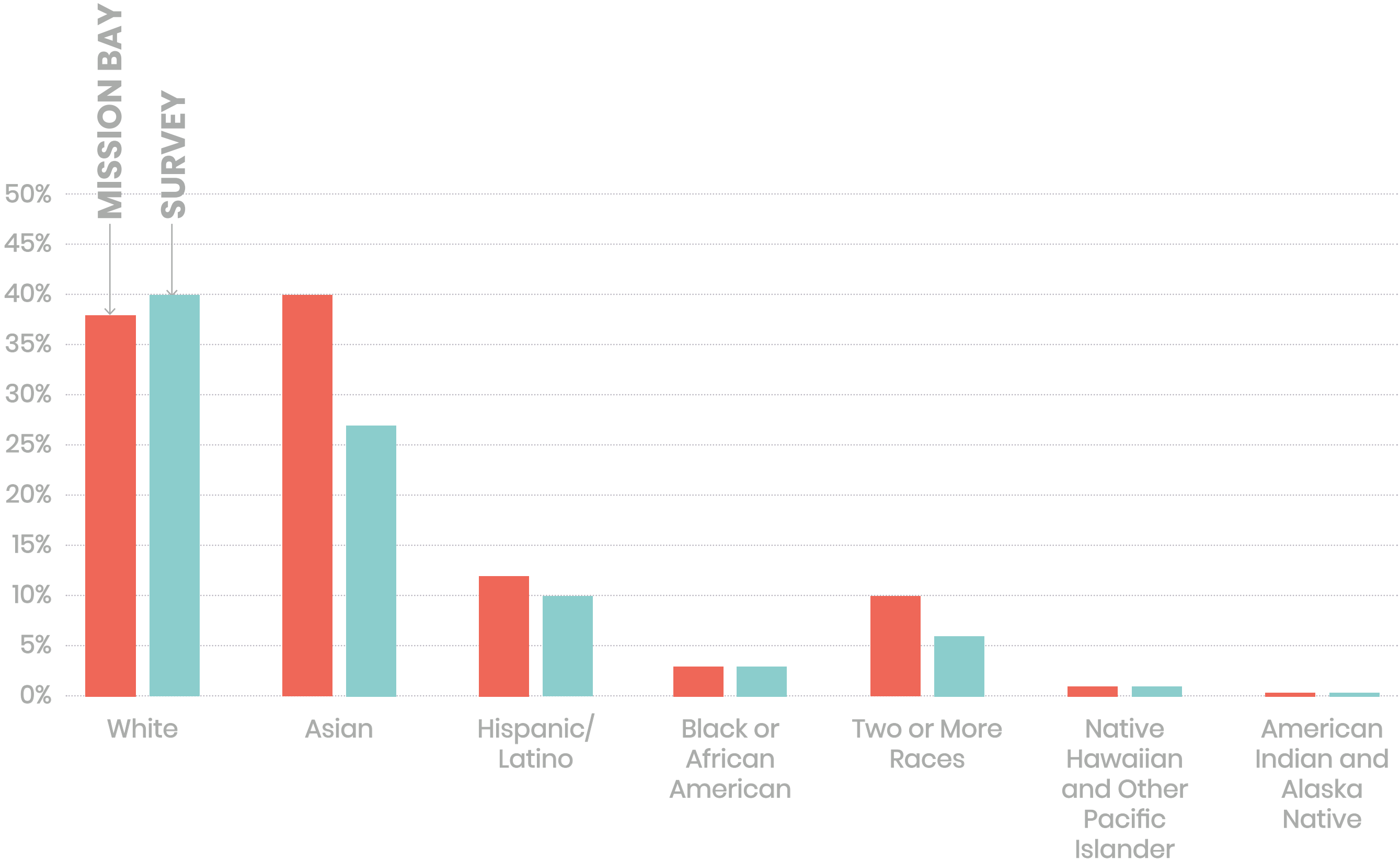

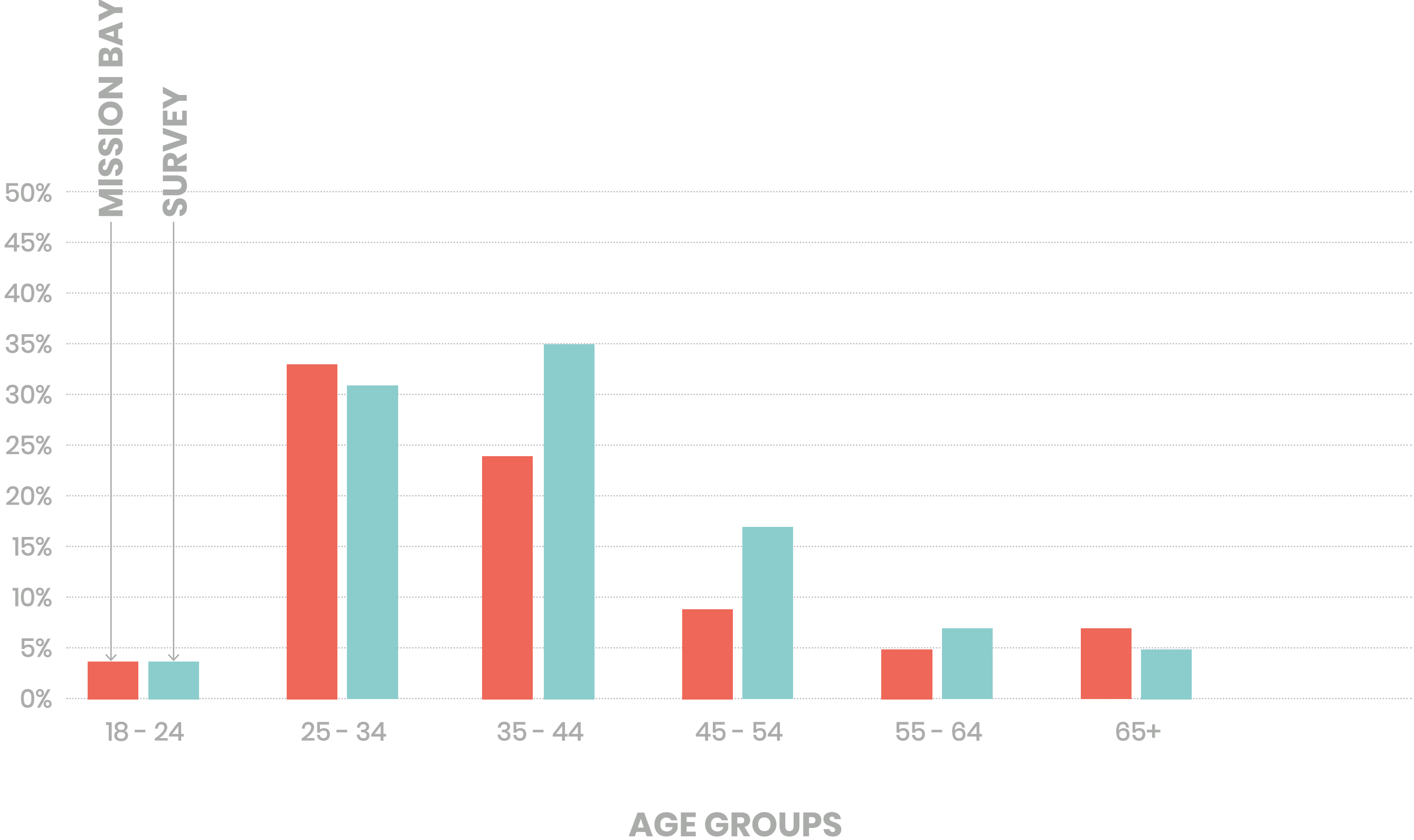

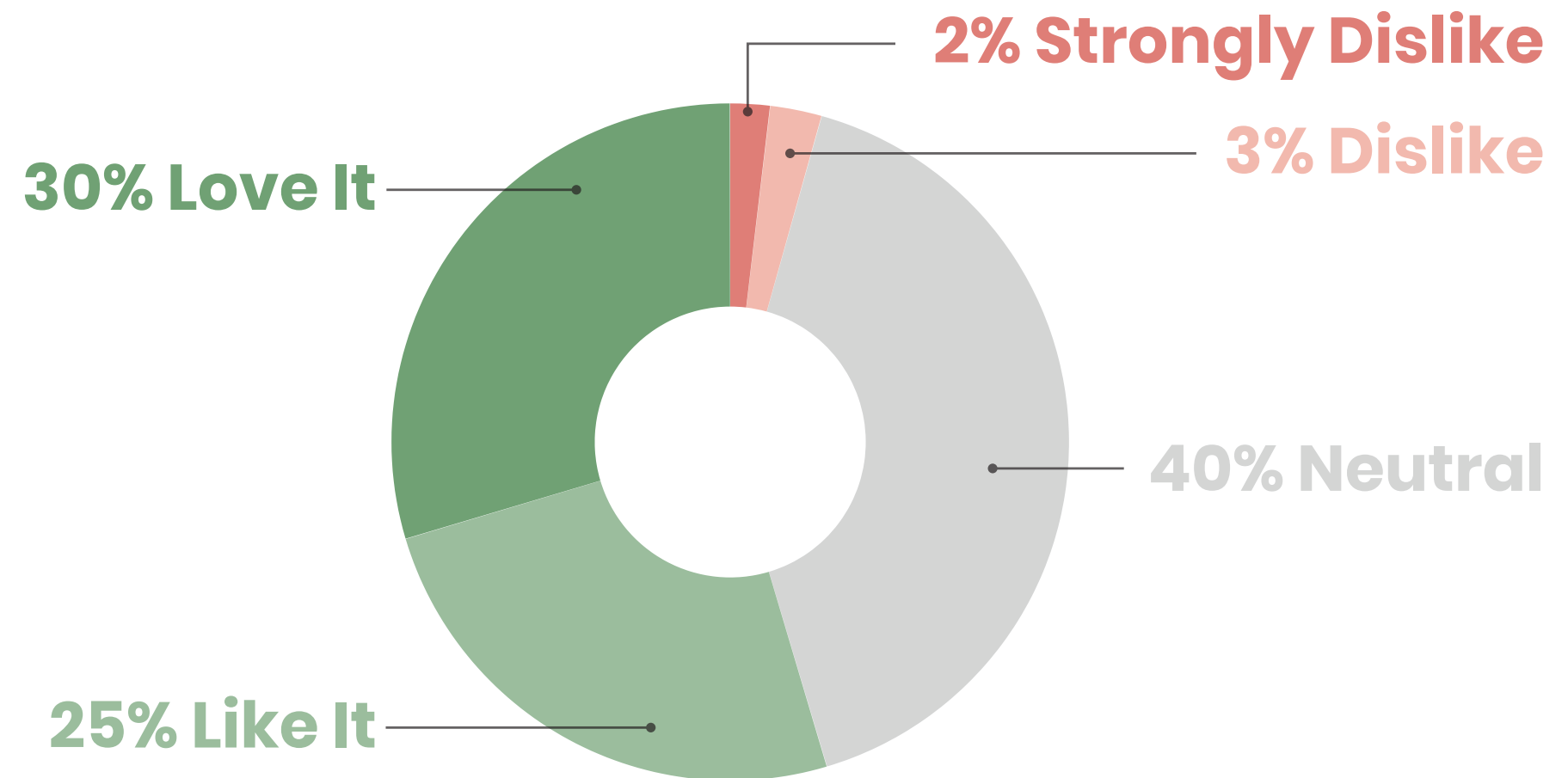

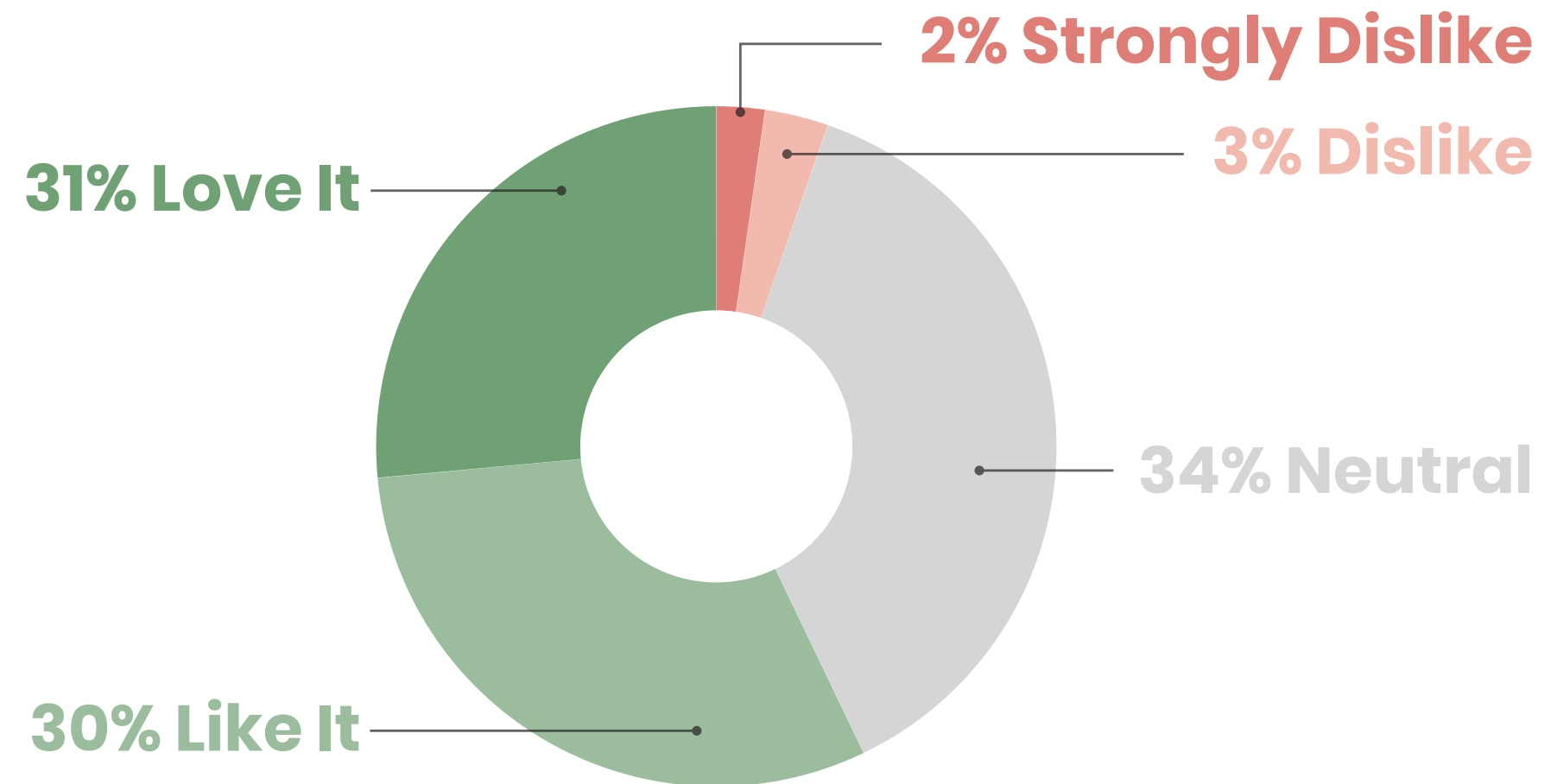
P12: Public Fitness Court

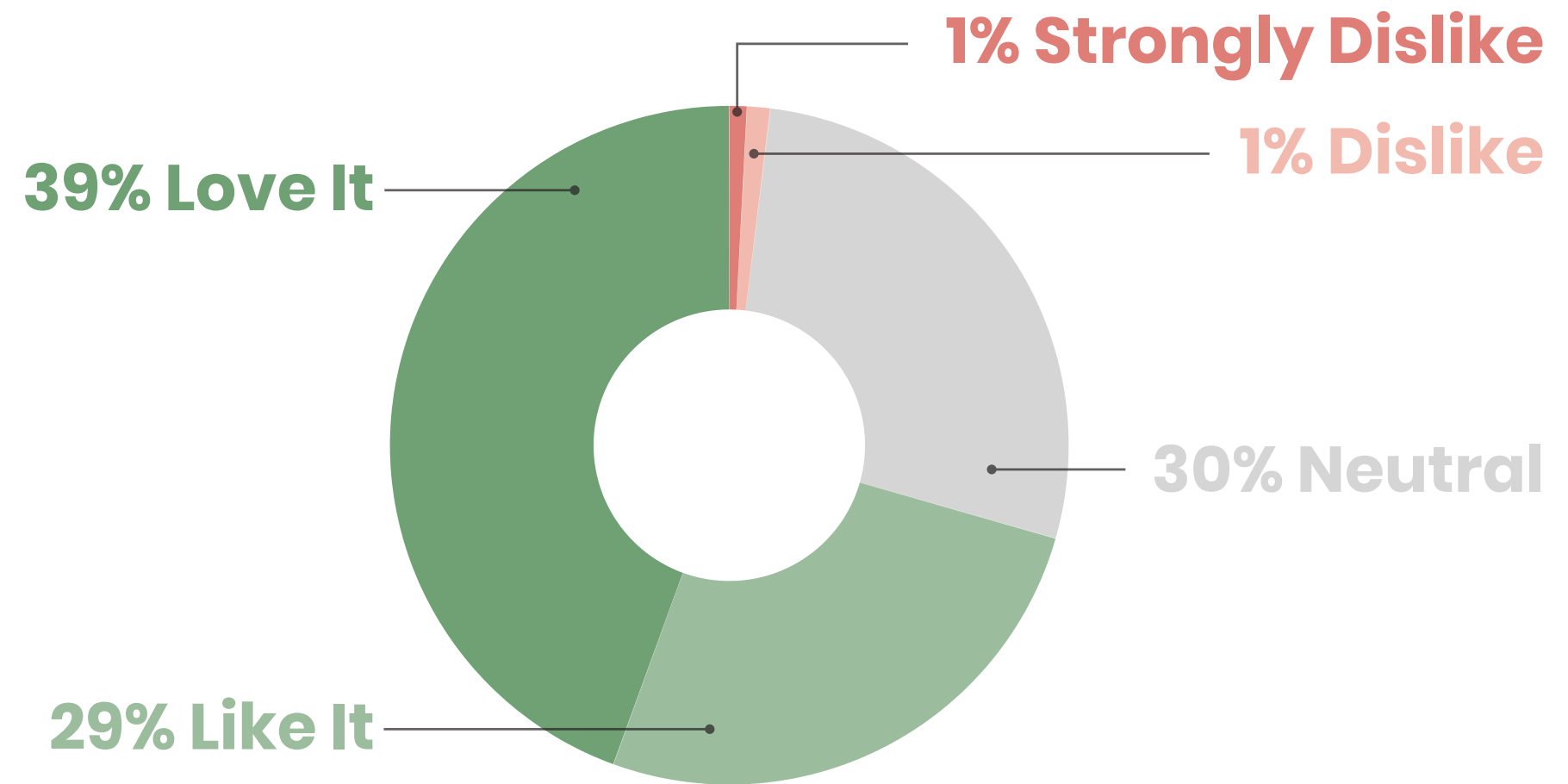
P13: Community Garden

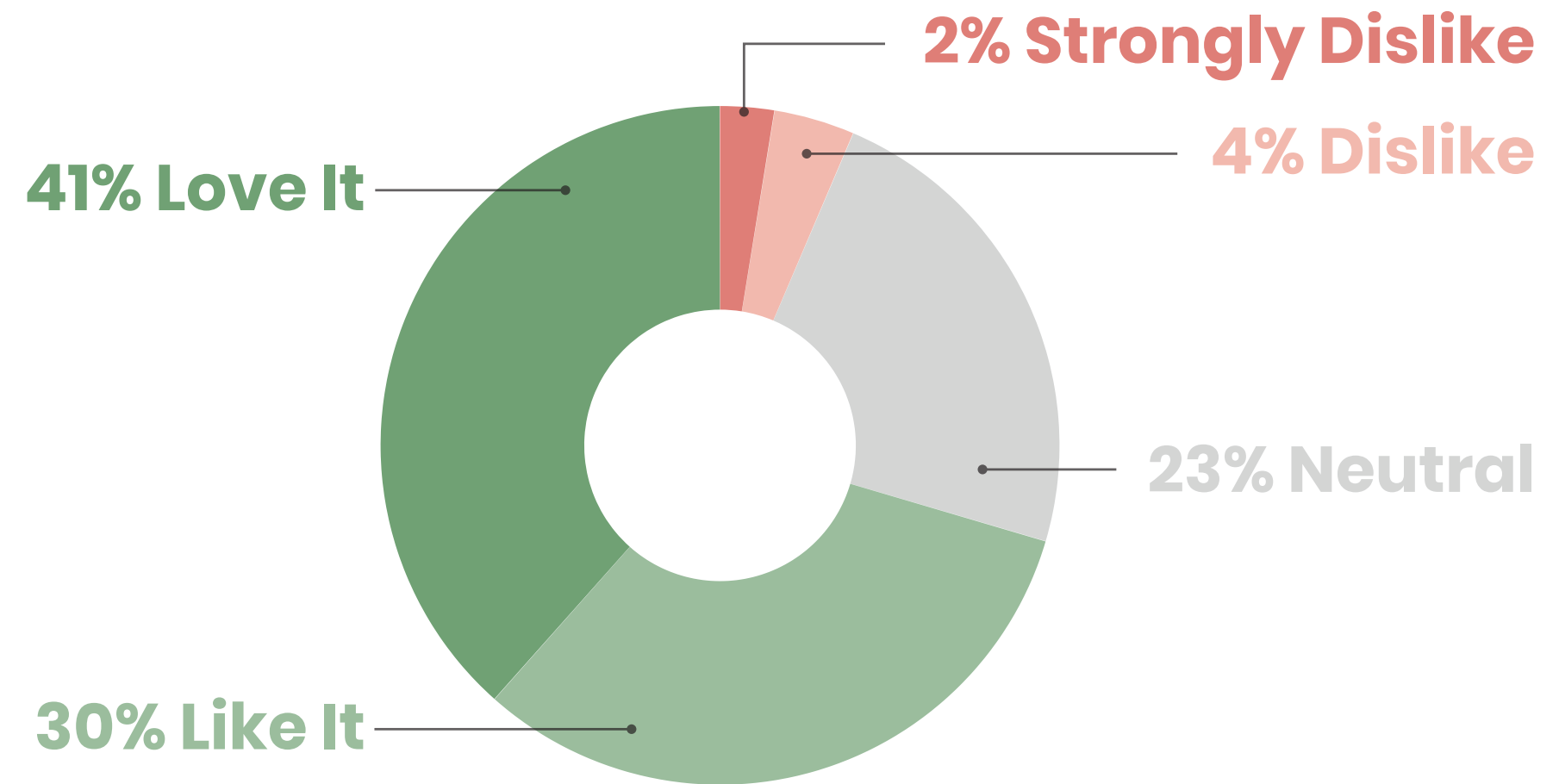

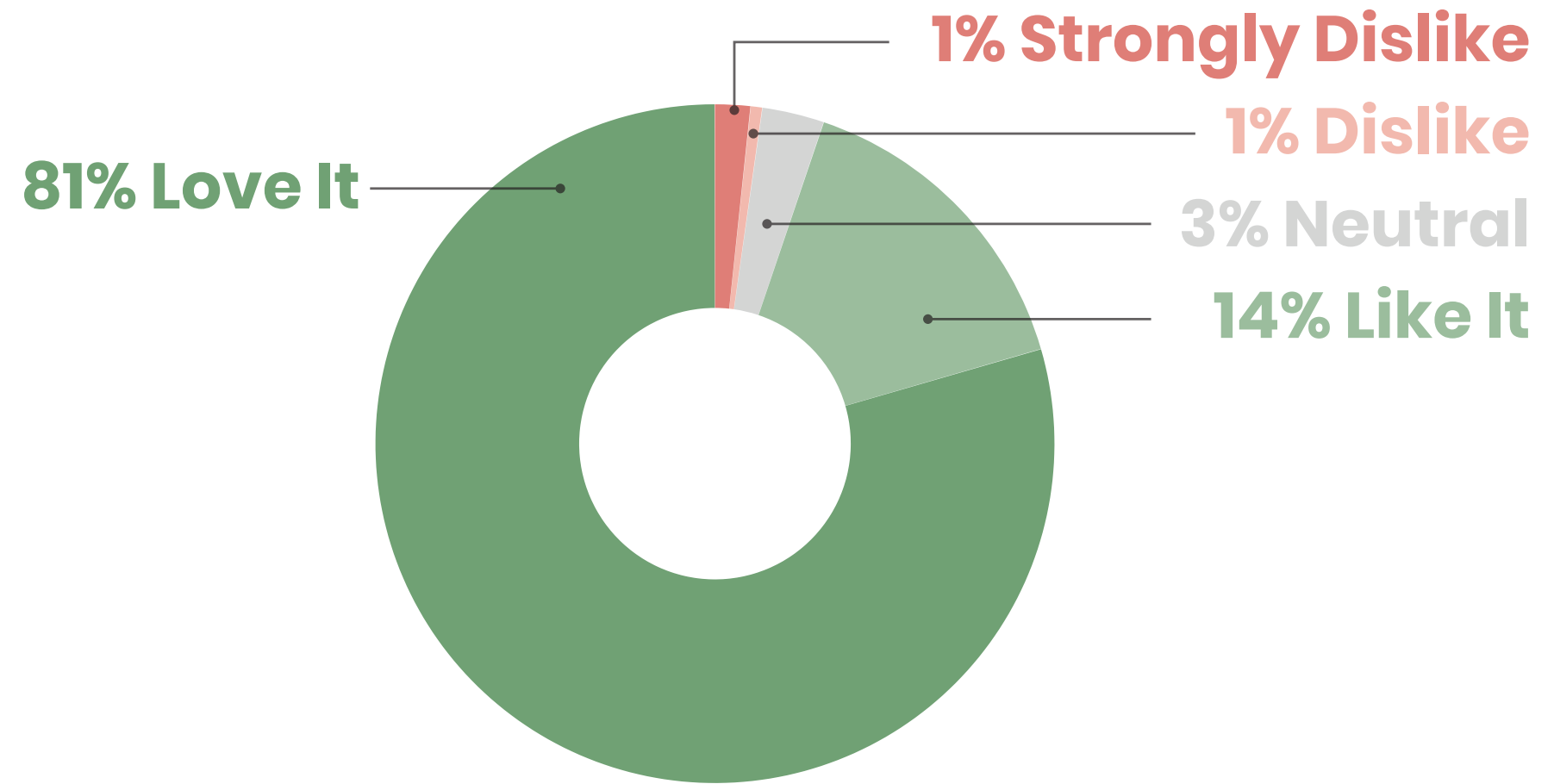

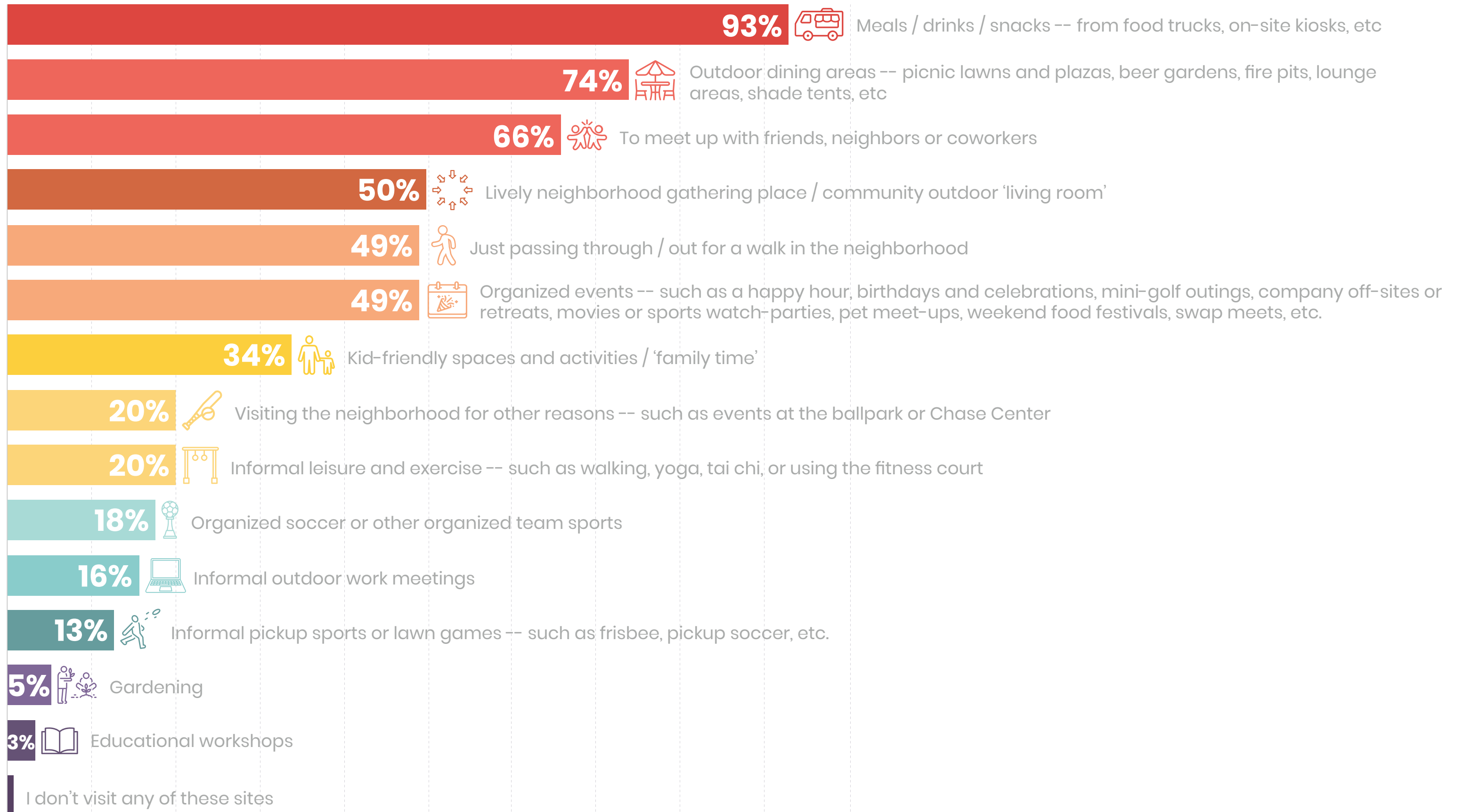

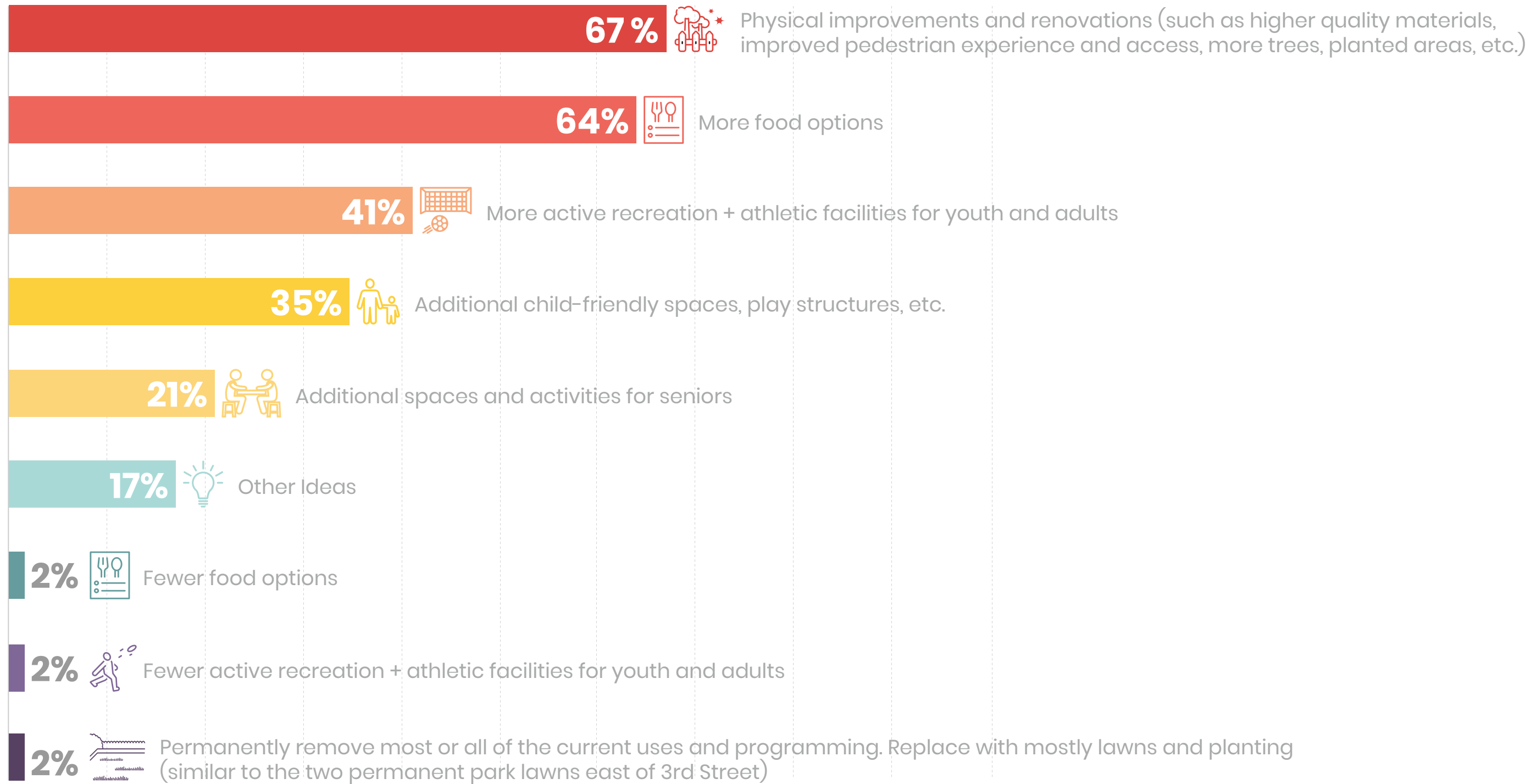

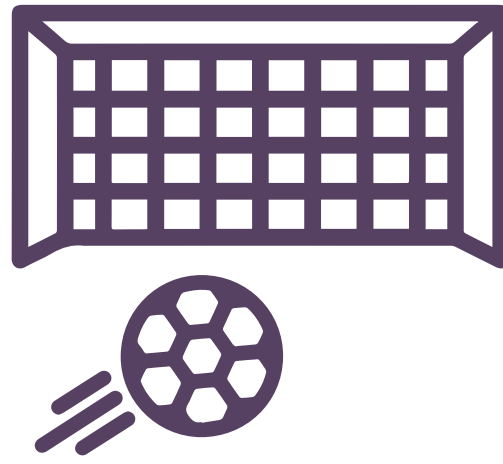
