Current Request

- **Authorize Interim Executive Director to enter into an MOU with the Art Commission**
- **Approve Public Art Project Plan for Park P2**

Background

- **Commercial/Retail Developers required to provide Public Art or pay in-lieu fee equal to 1% of hard costs.**
- **Approximately \$1.125M in in-lieu fees**
- **1999 MOU gives SFAC authority to approve design of Public Art on City property**
- **Art will be part of City's Civic Art Collection**

Proposed MOU Terms

- SFAC develops a Public Art Project Plan: identifies the art opportunities, project scope, budget, selection process, level of community involvement and timeline.
- Public Art Project Plan approved by OCII and Arts Commission.
- SFAC issues an RFQ based on the approved Public Art Project Plan
- OCII appoints a representative to the Artist Qualification Panel
- OCII appoints 2 representatives to the Artist Review Panel

Proposed MOU Terms cont.

- The proposed artwork of the 3 artist finalists present workshops to the MB CAC and OCII Commission.
- The Arts Commission will select the artist.
- Completed artwork becomes part of the Civic Art Collection.
- SFAC responsible for the long-term maintenance and repair.
 - OCII to assist with standard maintenance.

- Project to be located in Park P2
- Focal Sculpture or series of smaller sculptures
- Artist Recruitment
- Artist Selection
- \$1,125,000 budget

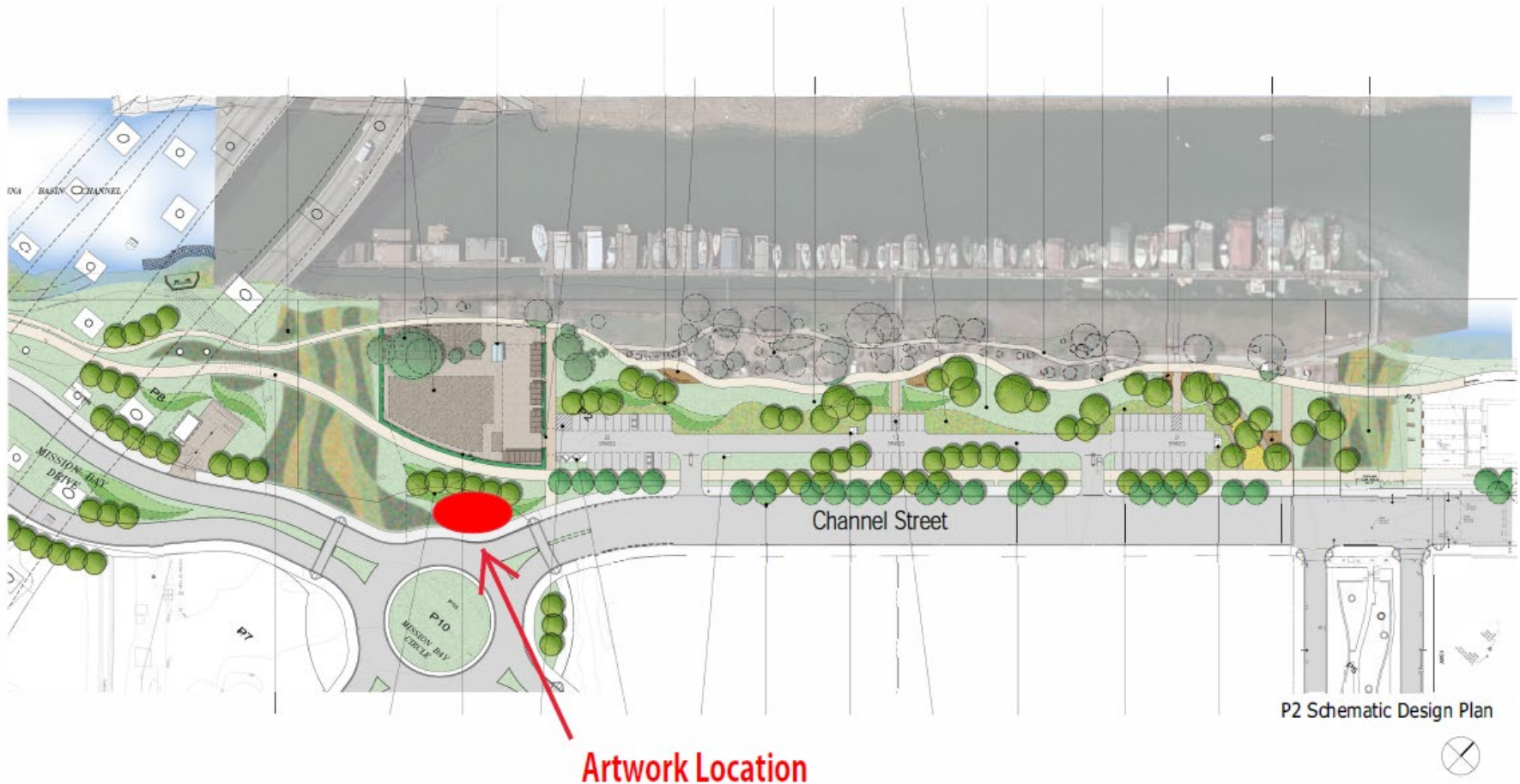

Artist Recruitment

- RFQ distributed to all networks and channels.
- Direct recruitment of local arts/SFAC prequalified pools
- Focus on artists with meaningful connection to the City and County of San Francisco
 - Scored Criteria
- Strong record of local artist representation
- Registered Local Business Enterprises will be given a rating bonus of 10% relative to other applicants

Artist Selection

- Artist Qualification Panel Screens RFQ Applicants.
- Artist Review Panel Selects List of 3 Finalists.
- Finalists presented to the community including MBCAC and CCII
- Artist Review Panel Recommends a Finalist
- Arts Commission Approves the Finalist

Proposed Budget

Mission Creek Park	
Proposed Mission Creek Park AE Budget	\$ 1,125,000
Admin (20%)	\$ 225,000
Conservation (10%)	\$ 112,500
Art (70%)	\$ 787,500

- Art costs include: 10% contingency, site work and installation, artist selection costs and misc. expenses.

Small Business Enterprise (SBE) and Contracting Program

- **SFAC will adhere to City contracting requirements**
- **Registered Local Business Enterprises given a rating bonus of 10%**

Community Outreach

- **Mission Bay Community Advisory Committee (CAC)**
 - MBCAC voted unanimously in favor of MOU on April 8, 2021
 - MBCAC voted unanimously in favor Public Art Project Plan on May 13, 2021
- **Artist Finalists Orientation with project Stakeholders**

- **RFQ issued June 21**
- **RFQ Deadline August 6**
- **3 Finalists Selected August 23**
- **Finalist Proposals Due October 8**
- **Arts Commission Approval December 6**
