SESAY ON THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESETTING OF PARCEL  
A & RELEASE OF PARCEL G DRAFT WORKPLAN FOR  
HUNTERS POINT NAVAL SHIPYARD CLEAN UP**

*Statement comes following the California Department of Public Health (“CDPH”) agreeing to retest Parcel A and the U.S. Navy’s release of a draft workplan for retesting of Parcel G at the former Hunters Point Naval Shipyard*

“OCII is very pleased that CDPH has agreed to retest Parcel A in July. The Navy and EPA continue to assure the public and us that Parcel A is safe, but all parties agree that concerns raised warrant retesting. We are pleased with the collaborative approach amongst Federal and State Agencies and welcome the support they have shown for the re-test of Parcel A. The health and safety of the residents and workers at the Shipyard is of the highest importance to us. We want everyone to feel safe and be proud of the Shipyard.

CDPH’s commitment to retest Parcel A in the coming weeks and the Navy’s release of the draft workplan for retesting Parcel G are necessary steps in ensuring the land is clean, safe and ready for development.”

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
