# Who Was Sister Lillian Murphy

- Sister Lillian Murphy, RSM, (B February 8, 1941, D July 25, 2019) was a driving force behind many meaningful efforts to prevent homelessness and improve the lives of people experiencing housing insecurity in California and beyond.
- In her 27 years as CEO of Mercy Housing, Inc, she expanded the organization from a small, regional housing development organization to the nation's largest nonprofit affordable housing developer, serving more than 40,000 residents across 21 states. Of the residents that Mercy serves more than 6,600 call San Francisco home.
- A proud native San Franciscan, Sister Lillian joined the Sisters of Mercy in Burlingame in 1959 at the age of 18. She later served as an administrator at San Francisco's St. Mary's Hospital
