AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED \$45,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT PICKUP TRUCKS FOR AGENCY PROPERTY MANAGEMENT


BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco ("Agency") has been replacing its pooled vehicles on an as-needed basis and as budget availability permits from year to year.
2. Staff has determined the need to replace two of the vehicles with Ford F150 pickup trucks. Property Management has an F250 that was recently purchased for large projects. The Agency has had good experiences with Ford trucks. The F150 trucks meet the requirements for routine Property Management projects, and they are highly rated for reliability.
3. The proposed action allows staff, pursuant to the terms of the Agency's Purchasing Policy, the ability to negotiate the best deal among dealers who comply with the Agency's Nondiscrimination in Contracts Policy for the suggested models.
4. Preliminary quotes indicate the cost for both vehicles with sales tax and other charges for options would not exceed \$45,000.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to expend funds not to exceed \$45,000 for the purchase of two replacement pickup trucks pursuant to the terms of the Agency's Purchasing Policy and the compliance of the dealer with the Agency's Nondiscrimination in Contracts Policy.
