COMMISSION MEETING OF JULY 23, 2002**


**BASIS FOR RESOLUTION**

1. The Redevelopment Agency Commission ("Commission") at its meeting of April 30, 2002 and June 11, 2002, considered the proposed amendment to the Agency's Housing Participation Policy to amend the housing participation requirements for all residential developments.
2. On June 11, 2002, the Commission voted unanimously to continue the matter until July 9, 2002. The Commission also directed staff to hold community meetings regarding the proposed revised policy.
3. In consultation with the Commission President and Vice President, Agency staff recommends that the Commission consideration be continued to the Commission meeting of July 23, 2002, to allow staff to conduct the community meetings on the proposed amendment to the Agency's Housing Participation Policy.

**RESOLUTION**

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED** by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that consideration of the Authorization of an Amendment to the Agency's Housing Participation Policy to Amend the Housing Participation Requirements for all residential developments shall be continued from the Commission meeting of July 9, 2002 to the Commission meeting of July 23, 2002.
