AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PERSONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH THE JAPANESE COMMUNITY YOUTH COUNCIL, FISCAL AGENT TO THE JAPANTOWN TASK FORCE, INC., TO EXTEND THE TIME OF COMPLETION TO DECEMBER 1, 2002, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE JAPANTOWN COMPREHENSIVE COMMUNITY PLAN;
WESTERN ADDITION A-2 REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA


BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

- A. On October 2, 2001, by Resolution No. 174-2001, the Commission approved a Personal Services Contract ("Contract") with the Japanese Community Youth Council ("JCYC") to provide fiscal services to the Japantown Task Force ("Task Force") for implementation of the Japantown Comprehensive Community Plan.
- B. The Contract provided for a Scope of Services, which includes developing a comprehensive database and a long-term strategic plan for the Japantown community, neither of which have been completed.
- C. Agency staff and the Task Force desire to extend the Time of Performance for 60 days to December 1, 2002, in order to complete the Scope of Services.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a First Amendment to the Personal Services Contract with the Japanese Community Youth Council, fiscal agent to the Japantown Task Force, Inc., to extend the time of completion to December 2, 2002, in connection with the implementation of the Japantown Comprehensive Community Plan.
