

## RESOLUTION NO. 87-2003

*Adopted June 10, 2003*

**AUTHORIZING A HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS SUPPORTIVE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CATHOLIC CHARITIES OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF SAN FRANCISCO, A CALIFORNIA NONPROFIT PUBLIC BENEFIT CORPORATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$674,231, FOR JULY 1, 2003 TO JUNE 30, 2004, FOR THE PETER CLAVER COMMUNITY FACILITY LOCATED AT 1340 GOLDEN GATE AVENUE, TO PROVIDE PROGRAM OPERATING AND SERVICE COSTS FOR PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS**


### BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco ("Agency") administers the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") program known as the Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS ("HOPWA") for San Francisco.
2. The Agency previously approved three HOPWA Capital Loan Agreements to Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of San Francisco, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, in an amount totaling \$450,938 for rehabilitation of the Peter Claver Community ("PCC") facility, a 32 bed licensed Residential Care Facility for the Chronically Ill ("RCF-CI") located at 1340 Golden Gate Avenue.
3. Since July 1995, the Agency has approved seven HOPWA Supportive Services Agreements with Catholic Charities, totaling \$4,901,259, to provide nursing attendant care, an on-site food program, and other operating costs for PCC.
4. Catholic Charities is now requesting a HOPWA Supportive Services Agreement ("Agreement") in an amount not to exceed \$674,231 for operating and service costs for July 1, 2003 to June 30, 2004. This represents a 5.1% reduction of HOPWA funding as compared to the HOPWA supportive services funding amount for the fiscal year 2002-2003. This reduction is necessary due to the 13.3% reduction of the HOPWA formula allocation funding to the San Francisco Eligible Metropolitan Statistical Area for the fiscal year 2003-2004.
5. The expenses requested by Catholic Charities are eligible expenses under the federal regulations governing the HOPWA program at 24 CFR 574 et seq., and the Agency desires to provide the funds through a HOPWA Supportive Services Agreement.

## RESOLUTION

**ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED** by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to execute a Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS Supportive Services Agreement with Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of San Francisco, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, in an amount not to exceed \$674,231, from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, for the Peter Claver Community facility at 1340 Golden Gate Avenue, to provide program operating and service costs for people living with HIV/AIDS, substantially in the form lodged with the Agency General Counsel.
