

RESOLUTION NO. 101-2003

Adopted June 24, 2003

AUTHORIZING A ONE-MONTH EXTENSION OF MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL 790, INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION OF PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNICAL ENGINEERS LOCAL 21, AND SAN FRANCISCO REDEVELOPMENT EMPLOYEE ASSOCIATION (PROFESSIONAL/TECHNICAL UNIT)

BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. By Resolution No. 184-2001, dated October 16, 2001, the Commission of the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco (Agency) authorized staff to execute a Memorandum of Agreement (Agreement) with IFPTE Local 21, which Agreement expires on June 30, 2003.
2. By Resolution No. 183-2001, also dated October 16, 2001, the Commission authorized staff to execute an Agreement with the San Francisco Redevelopment Employee Association (SFREA) Professional/Technical Unit, which Agreement expires on June 30, 2003.
3. By Resolution No. 104-2000, dated June 27, 2000, the Commission authorized staff to execute an Agreement with SEIU Local 790, which Agreement expires on June 30, 2003.
4. Due to a number of circumstances regarding contract negotiations, including a notification issue related to the IFPTE Local 21 Agreement and the Board of Supervisors' approval of the Agency's 30-day interim budget, it will not be possible to complete negotiations with IFPTE Local 21, SEIU Local 790 and the SFREA Professional/Technical Unit prior to the expiration of the existing contracts on June 30, 2003.
5. Staff recommends a one-month extension to permit completion of negotiations.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Executive Director is authorized to execute an extended Agreement with the SEIU Local 790, IFPTE Local 21, and SFREA Professional/ Technical Unit, for one month through July 31, 2003. Such extension does not materially affect the substance of the existing Agreements or materially increase the obligations of the Agency.
