COMMENDING AND EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO DOROTHY J. TANNER FOR HER SERVICES ON THE OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT FROM THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO

BASIS OF RESOLUTION

1. Dorothy J. Tanner was hired as a Senior Clerk Typist on October 17, 1983. While in that classification, Ms. Tanner worked in various Agency divisions including Affirmative Action, Engineering and Development Services.
2. Because of Ms. Tanner's skills, dedication and hard work, she was promoted to Principal Clerk Typist in Administrative Services on July 20, 1989. Always striving to broaden her knowledge and expertise, Ms. Tanner was next promoted to Administrative Assistant I for the Mayor's Office of Special Projects on August 12, 1991. Given her dedication to assist those in need, Ms. Tanner was next promoted to Community Services Representative in Central Relocation on September 25, 1995. As exemplified by her dedicated service, Ms. Tanner was later promoted to Senior Community Services Representative on November 3, 1998.
