CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN FRANCISCO**


BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. Mr. Kenneth Rawls, Facilities Maintenance Worker, in the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco's ("Agency") Property Management Division passed away on Saturday, January 7, 2006, after a brief illness.
2. Mr. Rawls began his public sector career as a Laborer with the Agency in May of 1973.
3. As a result of his hard work and dedication, Mr. Rawls was promoted to Laborer Supervisor in May of 1979. Mr. Rawls was reclassified to Facilities Maintenance Worker when his department downsized in 1987 and, among his many duties, regularly staffed the Agency Commission meetings. Mr. Rawls remained in his position until his recent disability retirement in December 2005.
4. Mr. Rawls was well liked by his co-workers in the Finance and Administration Division and especially those he worked most closely with in Property Management. He was also a dedicated member of SEIU Local 790.
5. Mr. Rawls will be sorely missed by his co-workers at the Agency and the general public, but we will have our pictures and fond memories to warm our hearts as we remember his smile and his kind words.
