

RESOLUTION NO. 105-2009

**AUTHORIZING A DESIGNATED PERIOD
FOR TWO YEARS ADDITIONAL SERVICE CREDIT UNDER CALPERS AND
CERTIFYING COMPLIANCE WITH CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE
SECTION 20903**

BASIS FOR RESOLUTION

1. The Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco ("Agency") is a contracting public agency of the Public Employees' Retirement System ("PERS").
2. The Agency must reduce staff and desires to provide an additional designated period for eligible employees to retire and elect the Two Years Additional Service Credit, pursuant to Section 20903 of the California Government Code and the Agency's PERS contract amendment providing for the Two Year Additional Service Credit that the Agency Commission adopted, by Resolution No. 144-88, on June 28, 1988.
3. The Agency desires to offer the Two Years Additional Service Credit to employees in the Architecture Unit because the Agency's annual budget for fiscal year 2009-10, as approved by the Board of Supervisors through Resolution No. 267-09, eliminated one of the positions in the Architecture Division.
4. Authorizing the additional Designated Period for Two Years Additional PERS Service Credit allows the Agency to provide additional retirement benefits to staff affected by reductions in the personnel budget and is an Agency administrative activity that is not a "Project" as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5), will not independently result in a physical change in the environment, and is not subject to environmental review under CEQA.

RESOLUTION

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco that the Redevelopment Agency Commission: 1) seeks to add another designated period for Two Years Additional Service Credit and hereby authorizes a designated period from October 7, 2009 through January 4, 2010 for eligible employees in the Architecture Division; 2) certifies the Agency's compliance with Section 20903 of the California Government Code, as described in the attached certification; and 3) authorizes the completion of the attached forms for submission to CalPERS.
