BASIS FOR RESOLUTION


1. Marie Browning, Records and Information Supervisor retired from the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of San Francisco after forty years of service on September 30, 2011.

Ms. Browning began her tenure at the Agency in 1971 as a Clerk Typist, and as rapidly as the Agency's records grew in volume, she advanced through the positions of Senior Clerk, Senior Records Clerk, Supervising Clerk, Microfilm Records Supervisor and, Records & Micrographics Manager. In 1995, she became the Agency's Records and Information Supervisor, which is the Agency's custodian of records for documents dating as far back as the Agency's inception in 1948.

Over the course of her forty years at the Agency, Ms. Browning's mastery of file organization and index compilation led her to acquire the technical skills necessary to manage the transfer of thousands of public records and historical documents initially to microfilm and now to the Agency's digital imaging system. Of equal importance, Ms. Browning's well-honed research skills, diligence and institutional memory have been relied upon by Agency staff, other government agencies, and the general public whenever any type of file, documentation, or information stored with Central Records was needed.
4. The Agency has benefited greatly from Ms. Browning's dedication, integrity, and professionalism. She is missed by her friends and colleagues and by all who have had the pleasure of working with her over the last forty years.
