250 Fremont and 400 Folsom are located on Transbay Block 8 which is composed of a 55 story tower and two mid-rise podium buildings. The tower includes 70 affordable units and the two podium style buildings contain 80 affordable rental units that are 100% affordable. The affordable apartments are available to families with incomes at or below 50% of Area Median Income (AMI) and will feature various resident amenity and open spaces including a fitness center, roof garden, lounge terrace, and community garden. Transbay Block 8 will play a critical role in further activating the neighborhood surrounding the new, state-of-the-art Transbay Transit Center as it creates a new mixed-use, mixed-income community in the heart of San Francisco.
