Background-Public Health Orders

- Mayor Breed's Proclamation Declaring Existence of a Local Emergency in connection with COVID-19 (February 25, 2020)
- The Board of Supervisors concurred in the proclamation and in the actions taken by Mayor to meet the emergency (March 4, 2020)
- The San Francisco County Health Officer Shelter in Place Order (March 16, 2020)
- Gov. Newsom proclaimed a state of emergency in California in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic, and that state of emergency remains in effect (March 6, 2020)

Background-COVID 19 Vaccination Requirements

- CCSF required all CCSF employees to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 by November 1, 2021
- The Successor Agency Commission approved OCII vaccination requirement policy on November 2, 2021
- Mayor London Breed issued the Thirty-Eighth Supplement to the Mayoral Proclamation requiring that members of City Policy Bodies be fully vaccinated by January 1, 2022 or those members would not be permitted to participate in an in-person meetings.

Commission Vaccination Requirement Policy

- The Commission needs to adopt its own Vaccination Requirement Policy as the Commission is not a City Body
- At the November 2, 2021 commission meeting, Chair Bustos requested staff bring forward a Commission Vaccination Requirement Policy:
 - On and after Jan 1, 2022, no member of the Commission can attend or participate in an in-person meeting unless fully vaccinated
 - By Dec 31, 2021 Commissioners must submit information to HR Manager stating whether the Commission member is fully vaccinated
 - Remains in effect during local emergency unless Mayor or BOS terminates the City Policy Body Vaccination Requirement
