<u>Description of Item:</u> The Port of San Francisco will present a summary of the <u>Draft Plan</u>, an important milestone in the San Francisco Waterfront Flood study. The Draft Plan seeks to build the City's flood defenses against sea level rise and flooding. The Port is seeking community feedback during a 60-day public comment period.
