*** STATEMENT *** OFFICE OF COMMUNITY INVESTMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURE ("OCII")

San Francisco— On November 16, 2020, the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") released a Parcel A Fact Sheet confirming that Bayview Hunters Point's Parcel A is suitable for Residential Use. Importantly, the EPA noted that the Hunters Point Naval Shipyard Superfund site (HPNS) does not include Parcel A, which was historically used by the Navy for residential and administrative purposes. The EPA confirmed that Parcel A is suitable for work, recreation and residential use. EPA's Parcel A Fact Sheet can be viewed at: https://semspub.epa.gov/work/09/100022040.pdf

EPA's mission is to protect human health and the environment. Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act ("CERCLA"), known also as Superfund CERCLA, the EPA is responsible for providing regulatory oversight of the Navy's environmental clean-up work at HPNS. The Navy is the lead agency responsible for the investigation and cleanup of HPNS. The EPA and California (regulatory) state partners oversee and enforce Navy compliance with Superfund and state requirements.

The Parcel A Fact Sheet also provides detailed information about retesting work currently being conducted at HPNS Parcel G and on-going remedial work at the former Shipyard.
